Year 1 Carnival Day

SATs

During the week beginning the 16th May, the children in Year 2 will sit new SATs papers. These national tests will form part of a teacher assessment for your child. SATs have been overhauled in Key Stage 1 to reflect the changes to the national curriculum, which was introduced in September 2014. The new curriculum has increased expectations for children in all year groups and teachers are working hard to ensure that as many children as possible achieve Age Related Expectations (ARE) at the end of the year. Year 2 children will take tests in Reading and Maths. The Spelling Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) test that all Year 2 children were due to complete in May has been scrapped for this year because the test paper was accidentally shared on the Department for Education website some months ago. We do not tell the children about these tests as we feel that they achieve better this way. You have no need to discuss the tests with them either. We don't want them to worry! Parking
