What is phonics?

Sounds

Words are made up of individual sounds. These sounds are blended together to form words.



Graphemes

A grapheme is another name for the letters we use to write the sound. In class children, use Fred Fingers to spell. E.g sh - i - p



English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)

One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.





How do I use the Virtual Classroom? Phonics videos are emailed half termly

- 1. Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child 3 times a week.
- 2. Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet or phone.
- 3. Praise your child as they join in with the lesson make it fun!

The more they practise using these films, the quicker they'll learn to read.





Practice at home- Reading books are sent home every Friday- please read frequently throughout the week and return the following Friday.

What can I do?
