He also enjoyed playing a wants and needs game with the Rights Respecting Team, and was impressed with the challenging questions that the Year 2 children asked him. It was fascinating to see and hear young children articulate their awareness and concerns. It gives me great hope for the future. It really was an amazing afternoon!





Safer Internet Day 2023



Little Barn Mobile Farm


The children in Reception had some very special visitors on Wednesday 22nd February - animals from the Little Barn Mobile Farm. Farmer Natalie brought with her: - a calf called Rosie, a ram called Jacob, a goat called Belle, a hen called Penny a guinea pig called Berty, 2 ducks called Geraldine and Jemima and 2 rabbits called Rose and Betty. All of the children were able to hold/stroke the guinea pig, the rabbits, hen and ducks. Farmer Natalie told us about her dairy farm.

She talked to us about the animals, how old they are, what the animals eat and lots of other information. We also found out the answer to our learning project question 'Do Cows Drink Milk?' The answer was they do when they are calves! All of the children were lucky enough to be able to give Rosie the calf a drink of milk.
