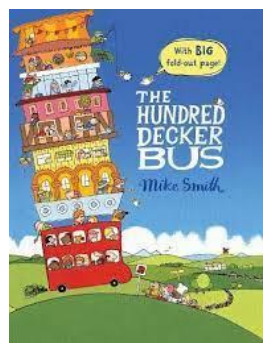



### Maths

This week we continued with the White Rose Maths topic 'To 20 and Beyond'. We have been focussing on:- subtraction, recognising the numerals 11 to 20, ordering numerals 11 to 20,

#MathsEveryoneCan

Play the 10 frame subtraction game with a friend.  
First collect 20 objects to fill two 10 frames. Take turns to roll the dice and take away the corresponding number of objects.




How many objects are left each time?  
The winner is the player that takes away the last object.

Play the race to 20 game with a friend.  
Roll a 1-3 dice and count on that number of spaces on the track.  
The first player to reach 20 is the winner.

How transport has changed through time



This week we have looked at some photographs of different types of transport. We discussed how the mode of transport compares from the past to the present.

Can your child remember the types of transport we looked at? Just for your information we looked at:- a steam train compared to a high speed rail train, penny farthing compared to a mountain bike, the first plane compared to a jet plane, a bus (like in the black and white picture above) compared to a double decker bus and a ship compared to a cruise liner.
