Subject Area	Task to Complete
Phonics	Just a reminder of the letter sounds we have already learned at Nursery:- m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, e, b, f, l, h and j. This week's sound is 'v' Using the 'I spy' sheet (this can be found on the home learning page) play the game 'I spy with my little eye, something beginning with' You might want to focus on the sounds we have covered so far that are listed above. Can your child find something with this weeks sound?
	I spy with my little eye
Reading / Storytelling	When sharing books this week, talk about what happened at the beginning and the end of the story. Who were the main characters?
Speaking and Listening	On the 'Sports Picture Sheet' (this can be found on the home learning page) look at the picture to talk about. What can your child see? What are the people doing? Try and ask some open questions e.g. why, where, what, how.
Writing	Talk to your child about how to write a 'v'. Encourage your child to write the letter in the air and then try to write some letter 'v's'.

Can you draw/paint/collage a vase of flowers or a vulture and write lots of v's around your picture saying the phrase as you write each letter "Down a wing, up a wing"

Mathematics


This week we are going to continue to look at money. (Please make sure you wash any coins well with soapy water before you use them.)

Have a look once again at the clean coins. Can your child see any numbers on the different coins? Like last week if you have 2 of each coin, it would be good if your child could match the coins. If you only have one of each coin you could refer to the coin sheet on the home learning page.

Coin rubbings

Place the clean coins on a table and a piece of paper over the coins, use a pencil crayon and rub over the paper and coin. Don't forget to rub both sides of the coin and look at how they are different.

Use I or 2 vegetables to print a picture using paint. Potatoes and carrots are good vegetables to print with and can be cut into different shapes.

On Sunday 21st June it is Father's Day. Can you make a card for your Daddy or Grandad?


