<b>1 – Overall objective</b>	To inspire creativity and self-expression, laying the foundations for a life-long love of music.
<b>2 – Key components</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Music curriculum through use of Charanga music scheme, Reception-Year 2.</li> <li>• Classroom instrumental/vocal teaching as provided by Trafford Music Service.</li> <li>• Clear progression from EYFS classroom music curriculum teaching to the end of KS1.</li> <li>• Clear progression of instrumental teaching through the consistent use of Trafford Music Service from Reception to Year 2.</li> <li>• Termly year group parent assemblies including music focus.</li> <li>• Christmas parent assemblies/singalongs for Nursery and Year 1.</li> <li>• Christmas productions for Reception and Year 2, performing for parents.</li> <li>• Extra-curricular Singing Club for KS1 children run by Trafford Music Service.</li> <li>• Strong musical links with Moorlands Junior School including Moorlands Orchestra/choir/recorder group visits.</li> <li>• Musical parents/parents that work in the Music industry invited into school to share their skills and knowledge.</li> <li>• After-school recorder club for KS1 children (Awaiting Trafford Music Service confirmation)</li> <li>• Oracy scheme of work including opportunities for 'Spotlight' presentations, from Nursery to Year 2.</li> <li>• KS1 singing assemblies</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Local secondary schools to share their music expertise e.g. performance of choir.</li> <li>Use of tailored listening scheme, to coordinate music listened to when coming in and out of assemblies.</li> <li>Staff who are musical/have a love of music to have the opportunity to share their knowledge and skills.</li> <li>Music Mark certificate achieved July 2023. (see attached)</li> </ul>
<b>3 – Classroom instrumental teaching</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through funding provided by the Friends of Templemoor, children from Reception to Year 2 have the opportunity to take part in an instrumental/vocal learning project, run by Trafford Music Service.</li> </ul>
<b>4 – Implementation of key components</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clear progression of knowledge and skills from Nursery to Year 2 (see attached document)</li> <li>Use of Charanga Music Scheme from Reception to Year 2.</li> <li>Use of Oracy Policy progression map to ensure progression of oracy skills from Nursery-Year 2 (see attached document) as included in assemblies and performances.</li> <li>Trafford Music Service staff run the Singing Club and all instrumental/vocal projects.</li> <li>Listening scheme and progression of singing skills using advice given by Trafford Music Service.</li> <li>Approach local secondary schools to encourage musical links.</li> </ul>
<b>5 – Communication activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Music offer displayed on Music tab of school website. Parents made aware of Musical opportunities both in curriculum time and as an extra-curricular club.</li> </ul>

<b>6 – Evaluation process for the success of the Music Development Plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use of Charanga Music Scheme to be reviewed, depending on amalgamation proposal, Spring 2024.</li> <li>• TMS Singing Club reviewed after each term.</li> <li>• Proposed recorder club set up by mid September 2023, reviewed termly by AL/SLT/TMS.</li> <li>• Singing assemblies to begin in Sept 2023, continually reviewed by AL, reviewed by SLT termly.</li> <li>• Use of listening scheme/music in assemblies to be in place for mid-September 2023. Reviewed by AL and SLT at Christmas 2023.</li> <li>• Oracy scheme linked and checked alongside assembly/performance requirements-Dec 2023.</li> </ul>
<b>7 – Transition work with local secondary schools *(N/A)</b>  <b>*Junior school</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strong musical links with Moorlands Junior School including Moorlands Orchestra/choir/recorder group visits.</li> <li>• Moorlands musical opportunities to be advertised at the end of the academic year 2023/4 to children leaving school to go to Year 3. Parents to be given information about how/when chdn will have these opportunities offered. Starting June 2024.</li> <li>• Year 2 music projects with TMS chosen with consideration as to what would lead on best to music provision in Year 3 at Moorlands.</li> </ul>
<b>8 – Budget materials and staffing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Friends of Templemoor generously fund Trafford Music Service provision from Reception to Year 2.</li> <li>• Extra-Curricular music sessions (Singing Club and Recorder Club) are funded by parents, operated directly by Trafford Music Service.</li> <li>• School pupil premium funding available for extra-curricular sessions.</li> <li>• Free Charanga Music Scheme training available for staff.</li> </ul>
<b>9 – Pupil Premium and SEND provision</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep a record of Pupil Premium children engaged in extra-curricular music activities. Review Pupil Premium budget and ensure quality provision for children who cannot access paid-for provision.</li> <li>• Regularly review access arrangements for SEN children within curriculum music lessons and beyond.</li> <li>• Review music curriculum with SENDCO to consider any adjustments needed for children with additional needs.</li> </ul>

<p><b>10 – Summary Action Plan</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Request to Friends of Templemoor for the funding of Trafford Music Service sessions for Reception to Year 2 has been approved.</li> <li>• Request to Trafford Music Service for session choices has been sent in and awaiting approval.</li> <li>• Request to Trafford Music Service to set up an after-school recorder club has been sent and is awaiting approval.</li> <li>• Singing Club advertisement assembly is scheduled for early Sept 2023, the club will restart soon afterwards.</li> <li>• Singing will begin during the Wednesday assemblies in early September.</li> <li>• Use of Listening scheme will be adopted and embedded in Sept 2023 for use in assemblies and classrooms.</li> <li>• Templemoor's Oracy Scheme will be reviewed and progressive Spotlight opportunities will take place from Nursery to Year 2.</li> <li>• Further musical opportunities to engage with and learn from Moorlands Junior School and local secondary schools will be planned and actioned.</li> <li>• Ensure that Pupil Premium children have fully funded access to extra-curricular music.</li> <li>• Work closely with the SENDCO to ensure that all children including those with additional needs, are able to access the music curriculum.</li> </ul>
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
