

You could have a go at designing a vehicle, using the cutting sheet on the home learning page. We have also included a scissor skills booklet too.


<u>Gross motor skills</u>- Can you make an obstacle course inside or outside? See if you can travel under, over and through. You can make it as small or big as you like.
