Wow we can't believe we are coming to the end of our topic

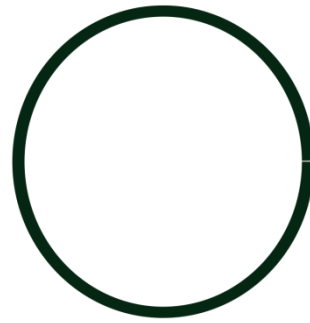
'Are we nearly there yet?'

Subject Area	Task to Complete																		
Phonics	Keep looking at those speed cards. Can you make as many words as you can in a minute? How many words can you make? Can you write a list using your ‘ Fred fingers’ to help you?

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Reading	<u>Reading for a purpose</u>																		
	As we said last week when we are travelling we often need to take food with us - either a packed lunch or a picnic. Can you find a recipe for a cake or a biscuit for a picnic? Read together and make, have fun and enjoy.																		
Writing	Write a list of all the different vehicles and types of transport you know. Write a sentence about your favourite vehicle. Remember to use your capital letters, full stops and finger spaces!																		

Handwriting – fine motor skills- cutting. This week we would like you to use scissors to cut out a circle, can you make it into a spiral.



Take care, it can be tricky.





You could have a go at designing a vehicle, using the cutting sheet on the home learning page. We have also included a scissor skills booklet too.

Gross motor skills- Can you make an obstacle course inside or outside? See if you can travel under, over and through. You can make it as small or big as you like.



Mathematics

Do you have any board games at home, with a dice or a spinner. E.g. snakes and ladders or Ludo. If you do, play a game with a grown up. Did you enjoy it? Could you make your own board game where you have to travel from one place to another? It will need a start and a finish. Can you think of any rules? E.g. If you roll a number 1 you can have an extra go? Or If you roll a 6 you can double your next number? You can use a small world vehicle or person as a counter.
