Muck, Mess and Mixtures



Punctuality and Attendance

We continue to carefully monitor attendance at school and work closely with our Education Welfare Officer, Mr Woods. We are pleased that our attendance rate is above national expectations, yet we always strive to do better and improve on the previous year. In line with the Department for Education guidance on absence, requests for holidays in term time will not be granted. The guidance makes it clear that headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. If your child is absent from school please let the office know before 9:30am and provide a written explanation on their return either in letter form or via an email to the school office. The Templemoor Mile

The Daily Mile now takes place in over 3600 primary schools and in over 35 countries around the world and the children (and staff!) really do love it! You may have heard the children in Years 1 and 2 talking about a 'Golden Table'. This is a really exciting reward initiative that we have just started here at Templemoor. Four children are chosen every Friday by our midday assistants to eat lunch at the 'Golden Table' with Mr Hodgson, in recognition of their good manners and outstanding behaviour in the dining hall and playground during the week. They have the privilege of a golden tablecloth, special trays and glasses, as well as decorations. The children chosen so far have thoroughly enjoyed their lunch and have felt very special.

Some gentle reminders for everyone's safety:

- Dogs are not permitted on the school grounds.
 Please tie them up at the gate, ensuring that they can be trusted to be left on their own.
- Smoking is not allowed in any area of the school grounds.
- We encourage children to ride bikes and scooters to school. When children arrive at the school gates they must dismount and walk their bike or scooter along through the pedestrian gate to the cycle racks. Children are not allowed to scoot or ride around the playground at the beginning or end of the day.

- Please do not allow your child to scoot, cycle or walk onto the car park.
- Children are not allowed to use the large climbing frame at the beginning or end of the day. They have plenty of time to use it during breaks and at lunchtimes when they are supervised by a member of staff!
