BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The children have already experienced drawing and painting self-portraits in Year 1. They have worked with a range of materials to produce a simple collage. This unit of work builds upon the children's drawing skills to produce a self-portrait as well as challenging their creativity to produce a collage.

- I know that different grades of pencil will create different visual effects.
- I can create a collage.
- I can use different kinds of materials to create my collage and explain why I have used them.
- •I know how to use shapes, textures, colours and patterns in my collage.

KEY SKILLS AND FACTS

- To use different grades of pencil to explore tone.

- To select with thought, different materials from a range of resources, considering content, shape, surface and texture.
