
Back to the 1970s



Covid Updates

Unfortunately, the virus is still with us and our region is experiencing a rise in Covid infections. We are trying to do everything we can to ensure the school and bubbles remain open and that the risk of infection is reduced within the school. We continue to follow Government guidelines and the protocols we have in place across the school.

We can still function effectively within the bubbles created for each year group and we aim to give all the children the best possible end to the term, and for our Year 2 children the best end to their time at Templemoor. I have to keep reminding myself that we are in a better position than we were this time last year.

Public Health England has said that it is crucial that everyone continues to follow the Hands, Face, Space rules and that all adults are vaccinated as soon as possible. This is the best chance we have to returning to normal school life in September. I urge you to be extremely vigilant and cautious make sure while on the school grounds you do not gather in groups, maintain social distancing and adhere to the one-way system, with only 1 adult to drop off/pick up at school. If you have anyone at home that is unwell, please book a PCR test for them immediately. If an adult or other member of the household is going for a Covid test you must not send your child into school while you wait for the results. Please all stay at home until you receive your results.



I am continuing to follow national and local developments closely in terms of Covid cases, and we are adapting our decisions and protocols accordingly. The safety and welfare of staff, children and families will always be paramount in all that we do, and so as a result this may lead to late changes to events etc. We will keep you as updated as possible. I am sure that you all agree it would be better to be cautious at this time rather than incur another national lockdown or tougher restrictions later in the year. We really cannot wait for restrictions to be fully lifted so that we can invite our families into school again! So keep going, we are nearly there!

Year 2 Leavers' Assembly

We are really hoping that the Year 2 Leavers' Assembly will take place on Thursday 22nd July. We are planning to hold the assembly outside, weather permitting. The assembly will need to keep within the Covid guidelines where no more than 30 can gather together. For this reason only 1 parent per family can attend the assembly. We will put 30 chairs out which will be socially distanced. Parents are permitted to record the assembly and take photographs however this must not be shared on social media or WhatsApp. The assembly will take place at 10am for parents of children in Class 1 and at 11am for parents of children in Class 2. If it is raining, we will record the assembly and make it available to you shortly afterwards.



Euro Event 2021

On Thursday 17th June, all of the children participated in football activities to celebrate the Euros. The children from Reception, Year One and Year Two were placed in teams. Each team was named after a nation competing in the Euros, and the children made flags representing their assigned country.

There were a range of amazing football activities, which were organised by Miss Salisbury and Mrs Brown, with support from Mr Bates, our P.E. Coach from the P.E. Sports Hub, including five-a-side football tournaments, penalty shoot-outs, dribbling games and lots more! All of the children demonstrated great football skills and superb 'sportspersonship'. Well done to Miss Salisbury, Mrs Brown and Mr Bates for organising this brilliant event, and to our wonderful children who gave their ultimate best!
