Phonics	<p>Recap your phonics cards daily. Write 5 different words in your home learning books.</p> <p>If you have access to a computer or tablet try to watch speed sound lessons on YouTube- Read, Write, Inc. via: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCI9GdxtQ</p> <p>Select a Set 1 or Set 2 sound lesson. Set 1 lessons start at 9am, Set 2 lessons start at 10am. Reading	Read a book of your choice together. Think again about the characters and the setting in the story. Can you tell a grown up what that setting is like? Use the pictures in the book to help you. Would you like to go to that setting? Why/why not? Try to share a book or tell a story each day.
Writing	<p>Imagine you have travelled to somewhere in the world. Can you write another postcard from where you are? Think carefully about who you are writing to and tell them where you are and how you got there. Is it hot or cold? What can you do there? Can you write your address on your postcard and draw a picture? You could use the postcard template if you wish.</p> <p>Remember to use your capital letters, full stops and finger spaces!</p> <p>Handwriting – Have a close look at capital letters. Can you carefully write all the letters of the alphabet in capital and lower case in your home learning book? Think carefully about forming the letters correctly and of the right size.</p> <p>After you have completed the ‘Project Work’ activity below, can you write about your journey under the sea, using the writing frame ‘Journey Under the Sea’, which can be found on the home learning page. Share your work with us. We can’t wait to find out what you saw on your exciting submarine journey!</p>
Mathematics	<p>White Rose Home Learning: https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/ On the White Rose website you will need to access - Early Years, Summer Term – Week 3. ‘The Very Hungry Caterpillar’. There are lots of fantastic activities on here, including creative ideas to make learning fun and link together! You could do a lesson or activity each day. Project Work	<p>Let’s look closely at ‘submarines’. Do you know anything about submarines or can you find out about submarines? Watch the Espresso video ‘Secrets under the Sea’.</p> <p>Can you draw a design of a submarine in your home learning books? Now can you make a model of your submarine based on your design? Think carefully about what materials you will use and how you will fix them together! Think back to your design of a boat – did we want it to float or sink? Will we want the submarine to do the same?</p> <p>Can you become a scientist and test if your submarine will float or sink? Why did it do that? How could you change your submarine to make it sink?</p> <p>Write what you find out in your home learning book. Complete the activity ‘Submarine Sights’ that can be found on the home learning page.</p>
