Spelling Strategies

- Mnemonic, e.g. because b big, e elephants, c can, a
 always, understand, s small, e elephants
- Syllables split longer, polysyllabic words into syllables (sound chunks), e.g. beautiful bea u ti ful
- Comparison spell a word by thinking of the spelling of a similar word, e.g. should, could, would
- Smaller words look for smaller words within bigger words, e.g. busy b us y or bus y
- Shape find the 'shape' of a word by drawing around the word
- Emphasis emphasise the 'tricky' part (s) of the word

This is by no means a definitive list. However, most children have had experience of using all, if not most, of the above strategies.
