Given the current situation with the Covid-19 pandemic, Headteachers from across Sale have met and consulted on a combined approach to being prepared for any directives/instructions regarding school closures and/or social distancing. **Please keep in mind that there are currently no plans to close school at the moment.**

As a precautionary measure, and in line with other schools locally, the school has taken the decision to postpone any events this term that involve large gatherings of visitors within the school. As a result, Miss Kelly and I have made the decision to cancel all of the parent consultation meetings scheduled for the next two weeks. We are extremely sorry for the short notice and any inconvenience caused. We aim to reschedule the meetings for after the Easter break.

In addition to the parent consultation meetings, the following school events have also been postponed:

- The Reception music assembly and Singing Club Assembly, scheduled for Wednesday 25th March have both been postponed.
