Reception Home Learning: **Week beginning 27<sup>th</sup> April 2020**



Welcome to your child's home learning pack for the week beginning **27<sup>th</sup> April**.

Here you will find a range of tasks that have been set by your child's class teacher to keep up with learning at home. We have given your child a book to record their learning progress. Happy learning!

Subject Area	Task to Complete
Phonics	<p>Recap your phonics cards daily. Write 5 different words in your home learning books.</p> <p>If you have access to a computer or tablet try to watch speed sound lessons on YouTube- Read, Write, Inc. via: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCIg9Gdx_tQ">https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCIg9Gdx_tQ</a></p> <p>Select a Set 1 or Set 2 sound lesson. Set 1 lessons start at 9am, Set 2 lessons start at 10am. (See phonics link below* and remember once a day is plenty).</p>
Reading	<p>Read a book of your choice together. Who are the characters in the story? Where is the story set? Were there any tricky words you came across? Think about how to use your phonic knowledge to work them out!</p>
Writing	<p>Can you make a postcard? Choose someone you would like to write to – this could be a family member you are missing, a friend, a teacher or even a celebrity! Can you tell them some of the things you have been getting up to? Don't forget your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops! Remember postcards need a lovely picture on the other side!</p>

	<p>Handwriting – Have a look at your address. Look at which parts have capital letters and which are numbers. Can you write out your address? You can either do this on your postcard, (if there is room), or in your home learning book. Think carefully about how to correctly form your letters and numbers!</p>
Mathematics	<p>Let's do a number hunt! Can you write out some numbers between 0 and 20 and get a grownup to hide them? Can you go on a hunt to find the numbers and tell your grownup which numbers you have found?</p> <p>White Rose Home Learning:</p> <p><a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/</a></p> <p>On the White Rose website you will need Early Years, Summer Term – <b>Week 2</b> 'Night Pirates'. There are lots of fantastic activities on here all based around pirates! You could do a lesson or activity each day. Project Work	<p>Let's look closely at 'boats'.</p> <p>Do you know anything about boats or can you find out about boats?</p> <p>Log in to Espresso – and search 'recycled boat'. Watch the video 'Recycled boat sets sail'.</p> <p>Can you draw a design of a boat in your home learning books? Now can you make your own model boat based on your design? Think carefully about what materials you will use and how you will fix them together! Can you become a scientist and test if your boat will float or sink? If it sinks, why do you think it did that? How could you change your boat to make it float?</p> <p>Write what you find out in your home learning book.</p> <p>Why not send a photograph of your model to your class teacher at <a href="mailto:homelearningR@templemoor.trafford.sch.uk">homelearningR@templemoor.trafford.sch.uk</a>. Online Learning	<p>Purple Mash: look on the 'to do' list and complete task.</p> <p>Although you may do additional activities, the Maths games are always good fun!</p> <p>Mathletics: Continue to work on tasks set but you can do more activities if you wish.</p> <p>Espresso: Have fun exploring the Foundation stage activities.</p>

On the home learning part of the school website you will find all of the resources you will need: 'acts of wildness cards' and 'calendar wall chart'.
