## Nursery Home Learning: Week Beginning 18th May 2020



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Subject Area	Task to Complete
Phonics	Just a reminder of the letter sounds we have already learned at
	Nursery:- m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, e, b, f, l and h.
	This week's sound is 'r'
	When writing the letter the phrases is 'Down the robots back and curl over his arm'.
	Find things around you in the house or on your daily exercise that start with 'r'.  Go on a 'r' letter hunt.
	Play 'Kim's Game' using objects beginning with 'r'.
	Play the sorting sounds powerpoint 'r' that can be found on the home learning page.
	We have also included an activity book to complete if you would like to.
Reading / Storytelling	Can each member of your family tell a story about the following pictures ?



Project Work continued	You could always make your own playdough fish, chips and peas! If you wanted to make them last longer make salt dough fish, chips and peas and cook them slowly in the oven. Colour the doughs with food colourings, show your child how to shape the dough into fish shapes, cut/shape the dough into chip shapes, roll peas into chunky ball shapes. Great for fine motor skills. There is a simple salt dough recipe available to download on the home learning page.  Have a look at the map attached on the home learning page of Lytham St. Annes (This is where we would have been going on the Nursery trip).  Talk with your child about what they can see on the map. Ask them questions E.g. Can you find the windmill/pier/Blackpool Tower/train track/beach/airport/ park etc.

Other tasks to complete	Learn a rhyme. Find a recipe in a cookbook or online. Find/buy the ingredients and help to make the recipe.  Practice putting socks and shoes on independently. This is a really important skill for school and it takes time to be able to do completely by yourself.
