# Settling in


- The Nursery Team are absolutely delighted with how well the children are settling into nursery and adapting to our routines.
- Please can you make sure you name your child's clothing particularly coats, hats and gloves.
- Soon your child will be given a Templemoor book bag, these are kindly funded by our fantastic 'Friends of Templemoor' (PTA). The Nursery Team will choose a library book with your child towards the end of the week. We then ask for you to return the library book the following Tuesday so we can the put the books into quarantine.
- Please can you make sure your child brings a water bottle (clearly named) everyday. If possible please could your child come into nursery holding their water bottle rather than it being in their bag, then it won't be forgotten!





### Curriculum

- This half term our topics are 'How Many Colours Are In A Rainbow' and 'All about Me'
- We are also working on getting to know our nursery friends and nursery adults.
- We have also been exploring our feelings using the story 'The Colour Monster' to help us.
- ▶ We are also working on encouraging the children to find out where things live in nursery, to tidy up when they have finished playing, to encourage the children to be independent e.g. putting on an apron before painting etc.







# A Typical Day In Nursery

Timetable

8.30am - 9.00am Nursery is open for children to be dropped off.

On arrival children sanitise their hands, hang up their coat, post their photo tag in their colour group basket (self registration), wash their hands and then go and play, learn and explore in nursery.

- **9.10am** Register, date, weather. Short session on the carpet e.g. Story focus, Maths focus, Listening game, Gross motor activity e.g. using ribbons to move to music, Music focus.
- **9.20am** Children explore and learn through their play using the continuous provision in nursery inside and outside. An adult will do a focus activity with a group of children or on a one to one.
- 10.20am Snack time. Children sit together and drink their milk/water and to eat their fruit snack. During this time we may :- talk about an object, listen to a story, sing/say number rhymes.
- 10.35am Children explore and learn through their play using the continuous provision in nursery inside and outside. An adult will do a focus activity with a group of children or on a one to one.
- 11.15am Tidy up, story time, wash hands, get ready for home time/lunchtime
- 11.30am Home time / lunchtime
- 12.20pm Some children go home after lunch.
- 12.50pm Register and afternoon carpet session (as above)
- 1.05pm Children explore and learn through their play using the continuous provision in nursery inside and outside. An adult will do a focus activity with a group of children or on a one to one.
- 2.45pm Tidy up, wash hands, get ready for home time.
- 2.55pm-3.20pm Parents can pick up their children, story time and play games.



### Lunchtimes

We have a wonderful team of midday assistants at lunchtime.

The children eat their lunch in the nursery building and then after lunch they play outside (weather depending).

# How to help your child at home

- Every Friday the office will email you the weekly Nursery link. This is a letter to tell you about what we have been learning about in nursery that week and any other information you may need to know.
- Please encourage your child to be independent e.g. putting on their own coat, putting on their own shoes, washing and drying their hands, using cutlery to feed themselves etc.
- The teachers at Templemoor have had training on Google classroom and we will be getting it up and running to assist with remote learning if we should need it. In the meantime we will be providing remote learning through the Templemoor Website if children need to self isolate/if the nursery bubble needs to close.



#### Reminders

- ▶ Just a reminder that children in Nursery play outside everyday. We experience all weather types and children do need a warm and waterproof coat with them everyday.
- Please can you make sure that you name your child's clothing particularly coats, hats and gloves.
- It is appreciated if you could bring in a named water bottle into nursery everyday so the children can independently access water as they are very active during the day.
- Please can you make sure hair is tied back everyday.
